Rules of Play

Three ways to play: 1) Individual Competition
2) Doubles
3) Alternate Shot

- 1) Set up the balls as indicated in the pictures.
- 2) On the score card, enter the amount of strokes taken by each player to sink all of the balls for each hole.
- 3) Called shots are not required if agreed amongst players before the game.
- 4) When scratching with cue ball, add one stroke to your score and return the cue ball to the starting point.
- 5) If a numbered ball leaves the table, place the ball on the foot spot and add one stroke to your score.
- 6) Jump balls are not allowed.
- 7) The winner is the player who has the lowest score after the 18 holes.
- 8) Maximum 8 shots per hole.
